## LEARN ALONGSIDE WORLD-CLASS HEALTH CARE ORGANIZATIONS

Goldfarb School of Nursing at Barnes-Jewish College partners with health care and educational institutions to support its mission of advancing learning, research and innovation within the nursing profession. Our clinical partnerships within the Washington University Medical Center campus and throughout the community, offer our nursing students a rich, inspiring environment where they can apply the information and skills they learn in the classroom and in the simulation labs. Many of our students conduct their clinical rotations at Barnes-Jewish Hospital and St. Louis Children's Hospital, two nationally recognized hospitals. We also partner with a number of other institutions within BJC HealthCare and other diverse clinical settings throughout St. Louis City, St. Louis County and St. Charles County. From rural clinics to inner-city hospitals, our clinical partners are helping us grow the number of baccalaureate-, masters- and doctorate-prepared nurses in the region.

To further the goal of improving patient safety and quality in health care, Goldfarb School of Nursing at Barnes-Jewish College works alongside St. Louis College of Pharmacy and Washington University School of Medicine in the Center for Interprofessional Practice and Education (CIPE) at Washington University Medical Center. The CIPE fosters interdisciplinary collaboration and teamwork through interprofessional education and encouraging a more cohesive care team that ultimately enhances patient outcomes.

## ADVANCED SIMULATION TECHNOLOGY

With our commitment to producing highly capable and analytical nurses, Goldfarb School of Nursing integrates simulation throughout the entire curriculum and in every clinical course. Our instructors teach nursing care using advanced simulation technology in the Clinical Simulation Institute (CSI), available at both campus sites. The simulation labs are equipped with some of the most advanced patient simulators and are closely aligned to actual hospital environments, including an operating room, critical care unit and patient exam rooms.

Through our simulation labs, we prepare future nurses with hands-on experience using the same equipment and resources they will use when caring for real patients at the bedside. Students develop increased competence and confidence through exposure to a wide variety of patient care situations, ultimately enhancing their ability to provide exceptional patient care.

## A SUPPORTIVE NETWORK FOR STUDENTS AND ALUMNI

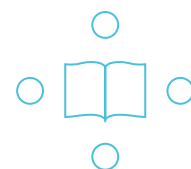
