

How To: Share or Save Badges

Badges are awarded to students via Canvas, Goldfarb School of Nursing's learning management system.

View Your Badges

Your badges can be viewed and accessed from within the Canvas course where you earned them. Click into the Canvas course, then, in the course menu, click "Badges."

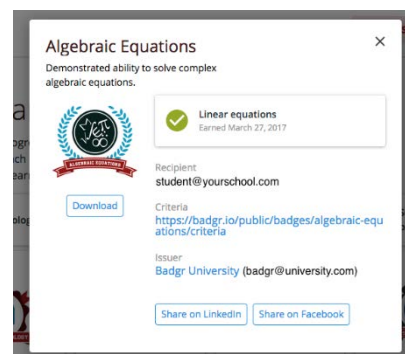
Social Media Sharing

Students can click each badge to learn more. For badges they've earned, they can download a portable Open Badge image that may be uploaded to a personal Badgr account or any other Open Badges-compatible backpack service. They may also share directly to social networks with the built-in sharing buttons.

Badgr Account and Backpack

Anyone who has earned a Badgr badge, in a Canvas course or elsewhere, may sign up for free at [Badgr.io](https://badgr.io) and use its backpack feature to store and share the badges they've earned to social networks like Facebook and LinkedIn. The backpack can store and manage badges issued from any Open Badges-compliant issuer on the web. Badge earners can take their badges on the go with the [iOS](#) or [Android](#) mobile app.



When you click on a badge in the Canvas course where you earned the badge, you have a few options for sharing:

1. Click the buttons to share the badge on LinkedIn, Facebook, or Twitter.
2. Click "Download" to download the image of your badge. This image includes metadata that can be used to verify your accomplishment. Employers can use [Badgr's verification services](#) to verify your badge with this downloaded image. Be sure to give employers your GSON email address to complete verification.
3. Click "View Criteria" to visit the public website for the badge. From this site, you can sign in to your Badgr account, sign up for a Badgr account, or copy the link to share online.

Canvas ePortfolio

Several of the sharing options above can be used to add your badges to a Canvas ePortfolio. You could upload the badge image, paste the link to the badge's public website, upload the badge certificate printed from your Backpack, or embed the badge information in an ePortfolio page.
