Upper Division Option

Barnes-Jewish College Goldfarb School of Nursing offers the Bachelor of Science in Nursing Upper Division Option, an entry-level nursing program for individuals who have completed their first two years of education at an accredited institution of higher learning.

The Upper Division Option is a full-time, five-term program that is comprised of 66 credit hours of nursing coursework. Applicants must complete 54 credit hours of prerequisite coursework at an accredited institution of higher learning. Barnes-Jewish College Goldfarb School of Nursing admits students for summer, fall and spring terms.

Classes are held during the full calendar year (three terms in a year), with classes offered in a day format. Students must be available a minimum of 30-40 hours per week, for coursework and simulation labs during the day or evenings and for clinical experiences during days, evenings and/or weekends. Students also have the opportunity to complete their clinical experiences at Barnes-Jewish Hospital and St. Louis Children's Hospital, as well as at other BJC HealthCare facilities and a variety of other community locations, up to a 70-mile radius, throughout St. Louis City, St. Louis County, St. Charles County and surrounding counties. The Upper Division Option prepares students to provide direct care to patients and their families in a variety of health care settings, as well as to pursue higher degrees in nursing. Passing the National Council Licensure Exam (NCLEX-RN[®]) exam is required to become an entry-level registered nurse.

The Upper Division Option is offered at two locations: the Duncan Campus Site on the Washington University Medical Campus and the West Campus Site on the Missouri Baptist Medical Center.

Barnes-Jewish College Goldfarb School of Nursing is accredited by the Higher Learning Commission (HLC), the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) and is approved by the Missouri State Board of Nursing.
