We Offer Three Paths to a BSN:

- *Are you working toward your associate's degree?* You can transfer to the Goldfarb [Upper Division BSN](#), a two-year (20-month) program that is effectively your junior and senior year of college.
- *Got a bachelor's degree already?* If you're taking prerequisites for nursing school here, and you have a non-nursing bachelor's degree, Goldfarb can offer you a 12-month [Accelerated BSN](#) to launch your career change.
- *Working full time with your associate's degree?* The Goldfarb [Weekend/Evening Option BSN](#) is a 36-month path to a nursing career.

Why Get a BSN? New graduate nurses in Missouri and Illinois earn \$67,544-\$72,505 per year on average (range \$61,000-\$81,000) as of October 2024. And for nurses, the BSN is often required in hiring or for career development.
