



## **Nurse Practitioner Program Faculty Clinical Guidelines**

The Clinical Faculty Member:

1. Provides students with course descriptions, objectives, and responsibilities of student, preceptor, and faculty prior to each course.
2. Assists students in securing appropriate clinical sites and preceptors.
3. Collaborates with graduate program manager to ensure student compliance with pre-clinical requirements.
4. Provides clinical rotation schedule to preceptors in set clinical areas prior to start of clinical rotation or term, as appropriate.
5. Provides course orientation material, including faculty contact information, to preceptors prior to start of clinical rotation or term.
6. Assumes primary responsibility for student throughout clinical experience.
7. Communicates regularly and addresses concerns and clinical issues, as needed, with preceptor and student.
8. Reviews and provides constructive feedback on progress notes from clinical and supports students in connecting knowledge obtained in academic setting with clinical experiences.
9. Reviews preceptor and student evaluations.
10. Participates in final evaluation of students' clinical performance and assigns course grade.
11. Communicates student feedback to preceptors at conclusion of each term or sooner, if necessary.
